COVID-19 CAMP PROCEDURE DOCUMENT

A detailed document outlining a COVID POLICY will be handed to each camp. This document will allow staff members to understand the procedures that need to be followed in the event that any staff and guest suspect to have COVID-19.

Guidelines directly from WHO (World Health Organization).



NO CONTACT THERMOMETER

As required by the health department, every individual entering any premises is required to have their temperature taken. Accordingly, no-contact thermometers will be operated throughout the day, taking the temperature of every individual before being allowed to enter any of the camps.



The same will be applied to all staff members before returning to the camps from leave. Staff will also be checked twice daily once before work and once during the day.

GLOVES

These will be supplied to all staff that are required to work with soiled linen, bins etc. It is also recommended for laundry and cleaning purposes. Gloves will also be used throughout the disinfecting process of all tents.



MASKS

All staff will be supplied with reusable masks, which the company will wash daily. Guests will be expected to bring and use their own masks which can be washed in their tents. Masks will also be available to purchase from each camp.



MAIN AREAS

Toilets & main area will be cleaned & disinfected regularly.

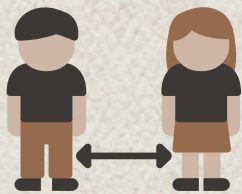
HAND SANITISER STATIONS

Hand sanitiser stations will be available throughout the camps. There will also be a supply of sanitisers on each vehicle and will be available in each room.



HEALTH DECLARATION

On arrival at each camp, every guest will be required to complete a brief declaration regarding their health and well-being. This documentation will be retained by management for record purposes. This will be done during the orientation process whilst completing your indemnities.



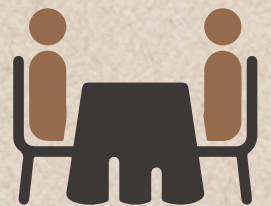
GAME DRIVE PROCEDURES

Guides will consider seat allocations, rather than alternating seats. That way each guest gets their designated seat and they can create a 'safe' environment. All camps offer a maximum of 6 guests per vehicle thus

ensuring each guest has a seat separating them. All vehicles will be disinfected after each activity.

KITCHEN & FOOD

- All kitchen staff will be dressed in accordance with COVID regulations
- Guests will be given the option to dine privately or communal style – this will be discussed together with managers and guides daily.
- Foods such as yoghurts, juices, game drive snacks will be served individually, with individual packaging



ROOMS

All rooms will be disinfected daily.

MACHABA PLEDGE

Once a tent has been disinfected, it will be secured with a Machaba Pledge seal which only the guest may break upon entering.
