The clear skies, low humidity, and minimal mosquito activity also contribute to comfortable conditions for safari activities.

"One month you can be on a game drive across a floodplain, and a few months later, you could be exploring that same area in a mokoro. This transformation is what makes timing your visit so important."

- **Activities:** This is the prime time for water-based activities like mokoro (dugout canoe) excursions and motorboat safaris,

alongside traditional 4x4 game drives and guided walks on the islands.

- **Wildlife:** Expect exceptional sightings of the Big Five, although rhinos are less common. It is a fantastic time to see large herds and the predators that follow them.

While some wildlife disperses due to the abundance of water across the region, the Green Season is a dream for birdwatchers, as migratory species arrive in vast numbers, filling the air with color and song. It is also a favored time for photographers, who are drawn to the dramatic skies, lush scenery, and beautiful light. With fewer tourists, this season provides a more intimate and exclusive-feeling safari.

- **Activities:** Land-based game drives are the primary activity, as lower water levels in some areas may limit mokoro trips. Walking safaris can be particularly rewarding, revealing the smaller details of the ecosystem.
- **Wildlife:** This is the best time for birding and to witness the spectacle of newborn animals. Many animals remain in the permanent water areas of the Delta.
